June 3-5

Romans 1:1-17

Memorization : Romans 1:16-17 "For I am not ashamed of the gospel; it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who has faith, to the Jew first and also to the Greek. For in it the righteousness of God is revealed through faith for faith; as it is written, 'The one who is righteous will live by faith.'"

June 6-9

Romans 1:18-3:20

Memorization: Romans 2:29 "Rather, a person is a Jew who is one inwardly, and real circumcision is a matter of the heart – it is spiritual and not literal. Such a person receives praise not from others but from God."

June 10-13

Romans 3:21-4:25

Memorization: Romans 3:28 "For we hold that a person is justified by faith apart from works prescribed by the law."

June 17-24

Romans 5

Memorization: Romans 5:8 "But God proves his love for us in that while we still were sinners Christ died for us."

June 25-30

Romans 6

Memorization: Romans 6:10-11 "The death he died, he died to sin, once for all; but the life he lives, he lives to God. So you also must consider yourselves dead to sin and alive to God in Christ Jesus."

July 3-8

Romans 7

Memorization: Romans 7:18-20 "For I know that nothing good dwells within me, that is, in my flesh. I can will what is right, but I cannot do it. For I do not do the good I want, but the evil I do not want is what I do. Now if I do what I do not want, it is no longer I that do it, but sin that dwells within me."

July 9-15

Romans 8

Memorization: Romans 8: 24-25 "For in hope we were saved. Now hope that is seen is not hope. For who hopes for what is seen? But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience."
Romans 8:28 "We know that all things work together for good for those who love God, who are called according to his purpose."
Romans 8:30 "And those whom he predestined he also called; and those whom he called he also justified, and those whom he justified he also glorified."

July 16-22

Reread all of Romans 1-5

Memorization: Romans 5:3-5 "And not only that, but we also boast in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy spirit that has been given to us."

July 23-August 4

Reread all of Romans 6-8

Memorization: Romans 8:31 "What then are we to say about these things? If God is for us, who is against us?"
Romans 8:38-39 "For I am convinced that neither death, nor life, nor angels, nor rulers, nor things present, nor things to come, nor powers, or height, nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord."

August 5-11

Romans 9

Memorization: Romans 9:31-32 "but Israel, who did strive for the righteousness that is based on the law, did not succeed in fulfilling that law. Why not? Because they did not strive for it on the basis of faith, but as if it were based on works. They have stumbled over the stumbling stone."

August 12-18

Romans 10

Memorization: Romans 10:9-10 "because if you confess with your lips that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For one believes with the heart and so is justified, and one confesses with the mouth and so is saved."

August 19-25

Romans 11

Memorization: Romans 11:5-6 "So too at the present time there is a remnant, chosen by grace. But if it is by grace, it is no longer on the basis of works, otherwise grace would no longer be grace."

August 26-September 1

Romans 12

Memorization: Romans 12:1-2 "I appeal to you therefore, brothers and sisters, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your minds, so that you may discern what is the will of God – what is good and acceptable and perfect."

September 2-8

Romans 13

Memorization: Romans 13:8-10 "Owe no one anything, except to love one another; for the one who loves another has fulfilled the law. The commandments, 'You shall not commit adultery; You shall not murder; You shall not steal; You shall not covet'; and any other commandment, are summed up in this word, 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' Love does no wrong to a neighbor; therefore, love is the fulfilling of the law."

September 9-15

Romans 14

Memorization: Romans 14:7-9 "We do not live to ourselves, and we do not die to ourselves. If we live, we live to the Lord, and if we die, we die to the Lord; so then, whether we live or whether we die, we are the Lord's. For to this end Christ died and lived again, so that he might be Lord of both the dead and the living."

September 16-22

Romans 15

Memorization: Romans 15:5-6 "May the God of steadfastness and encouragement grant you to live in harmony with one another in accordance with Christ Jesus, so that together you may with one voice glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ."

September 23-29

Romans 16

Memorization challenge: Romans 12:9-21
